SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Under Decision No. 11954 dated April 24, 1923, in Application No. 8749 the Railroad Commission granted to John Simon a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the operation of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers between Pasadena, San Gabriel, East San Gabriel and the intersection of San Gabriel Boulevard and Garvey Road. Under Decision No. 12101 in Application No. 9013 the Railroad Commission authorized said John Simon to transfer one-half interest in his operative right to Robert Campbell. Subsequent thereto the co-partnership consisting of Simon and Campbell filed a signed statement with the Commission showing that a loss of \$128.95 was incurred by such co-partnership during five days of operation and

that after a thorough investigation of possible traffic which might be developed in this territory the co-partnership has come to the conclusion that operation could only be continued at a considerable loss entirely beyond their financial ability to reach. They accordingly request that the certificate be revoked and annulled.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the operative right established under the above numbered decision be, and the same hereby is revoked and annulled.
