SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Under Decision No. 9165, dated June 27, 1921, in the above entitled application United Stages, Inc., was authorized to lease to E. B. Stevenson a certain operative right authorizing the operation of automobile stage service between Mecca and Blythe, California. The proposed lease was to expire on December 31, 1923, but under supplemental application filed on July 14, 1923, applicants requested that said lease be cancelled permitting discontinuance of service by E. B. Stevenson as of September 30, 1923 and resumption of service by the United Stages, Inc., on October 1st, 1923.
