O R D E R

WHEREAS, on June 29, 1923, this Commission issued its Order No. 12,293 approving a certain wharf franchise more particularly described in said order; and

WHEREAS; in said order it was provided that such approval order should not become effective until Rodeo-Vallejo Ferry Company should file with this Commission, for approval, a stipulation duly authorized by its Board of Directors declaring that neither it, nor its successors nor assigns will ever claim before the Railroad Commission or any court or other public body any value for said wharf franchise in excess of the amount actually paid to the County of Contra Costa for the grant of said franchise, which amount was to be included in said stipulation; and

WHEREAS, Rodeo-Vallejo Ferry Company has filed with this Commission a stipulation of such character which this Commission now declares to be in form satisfactory to it;

NOW THEREFORE, the Railroad Commission of the State of California hereby approves said stipulation, and declares its said order No. 12,293 to be effective from this day forward.
