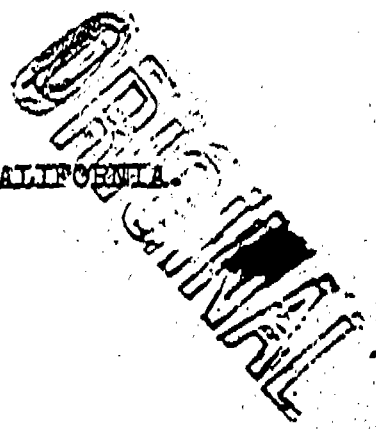


Decision No. 12563.



BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of the Application
of the WEST ANAHEIM WATER COMPANY,
a corporation, for an order auth-
orizing said corporation to abandon
its public utility service and to
resume the status of a strictly
mutual company.

BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER AUTHORIZING ABANDONMENT
OF PUBLIC UTILITY SERVICE.

WEST ANAHEIM WATER COMPANY having filed with this Com-
mission on August 6, 1923, an application to abandon all
public utility service heretofore maintained by said appli-
cant; and it appearing from said application that this appli-
cant has heretofore operated primarily as a mutual water
company, serving its stockholders at cost, and that its
public utility service has consisted of a service to a limi-
ted number of non-stockholders, all of whom now desire to
become stockholders of the company, whereby the entire ser-
vice will be that of a mutual company;

And it further appearing that this is not a matter in
which a public hearing is required, and that it is in the

public interest that said application be granted:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the application of the West
Anaheim Water Company be, and the same is hereby granted.
