and it appearing that the sole property involved in the trans-
portation service authorized to be engaged in by applicant under
Decision No. 10119, dated February 24, 1922, is for the trans-
portation of milk directly from dairies to creameries over a
specifically defined route in said application; and that such
class of transportation service is not subject to the provisions
of regulation under the amendment known as the Crittenden Bill,
Chapter 310, Statutes of 1923, effective August 17, 1923.
