O R D E R

Clara E. Coffee having asked for authority to transfer to R. L. Young the Glen Arbor Water System, supplying consumers in the town of Glen Arbor, Santa Cruz County, and R. L. Young having joined in the application, and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Clara E. Coffee be and she is hereby authorized to transfer to R. L. Young a certain public utility water system known as the Glen Arbor Water System, located in Santa Cruz County, upon the following conditions:

1. The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall have been made on or before December 31, 1923, and a certified copy of the instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by said Clara E. Coffee within thirty (30) days from the date on which it is executed.
2. Within ten (10) days from the date on which Clara E. Coffee actually relinquishes control and possession of the property herein authorized to be sold, she shall file with this Commission a certified statement indicating the date upon which such control and possession was relinquished.

3. The consideration given for the transfer of this property shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of value of the property for rate fixing or for any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.
