ORDER

H. K. Sears having applied to this Commission for authority to sell to C. J. Lee a certain public utility water system commonly known as the Gerber Water Works, located at Gerber, Tehama County, and C. J. Lee having joined in the application,

And it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that H. K. Sears be and he is hereby authorized to transfer the public utility water system located at Gerber, Tehama County, and commonly known as the Gerber Water Works, to C. J. Lee upon the terms and conditions set out in the application herein, and subject to the following further conditions:

1. The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall have been completed on or before March 1, 1924, and a certified copy of the instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by said H. K. Sears within thirty (30) days from the date on which it is executed.

2. Within ten (10) days from the date on which H. K. Sears actually relinquishes control and possession of the property herein authorized to be sold, he shall file with this Commission a certified statement indicating the date upon which such control and possession was relinquished.
3. The consideration given for the transfer of this property shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of value of the property for rate fixing or for any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.
