SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Under Decision No. 12392, dated July 24, 1923, the Railroad Commission granted to applicant a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the operation of automobile truck line as a common carrier of freight, express and baggage between Fresno and Pinedale and intermediate points, California. Condition No. 3 of said Decision provided that applicant should file, in duplicate, tariffs and time schedules and should commence operation under said certificate within a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days from date of said Decision. A number of communications have been addressed to applicant through his attorney, namely, on August 3, September 14, September 19, and October 5, 1923, calling his attention to the conditions of the order under which such certificate was established. No reply was received to any of such communications other than a written communication from the attorney for applicant to the effect that he did not know the whereabouts of his client nor whether or not he intended to accept the certificate or operate thereunder; and no tariffs nor time schedules having been filed,
