FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Railroad Commission having on the 7th day of September, 1923, made its Order in the above entitled matter involving the rates of Pacific Gas and Electric Company for steam heating service, and Pacific Gas and Electric Company having filed with the Railroad Commission its petition for a modification of said Order so as to provide that the rates therein fixed shall be subject to increase or decrease on the basis of four cents per thousand pounds of steam for each ten cents per barrel increase or decrease respectively in the cost of oil instead of on the basis of three cents per thousand pounds as provided in said Order, and the Railroad Commission having considered said petition for modification and still being of the opinion that the rates provided

in said Order are just and reasonable,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the petition of Pacific Gas and Electric Company for modification of the Order in Decision Number 12580 in the above entitled matter dated September 7, 1923, be and the same is hereby denied.
