ORDER

R. E. Riley has filed an application with Ernest.

R. Blue in which they petition for an order authorizing Riley to sell and Blue to purchase and operate a certain automotive stage line at the present time being operated by applicant Riley between Chico and Willows and intermediate points, California.

The operative right herein proposed to be transferred was obtained by applicant Riley under Decision No. 11844
in Application No. 8808, dated March 29, 1923, which decision
authorized one Hall to transfer to Riley the certificate held by
him authorizing operation of automotive passenger and express
stage service between the points hereinabove mentioned.

The consideration proposed to be paid for the property herein proposed to be transferred is given as the sum of \$1660.00, the application reciting that all of this amount with the exception of \$50.00 represents the present value of stage equipment proposed to be transferred.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should

be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be, and the same hereby is granted, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The consideration to be paid for the property herein authorized to be transferred shall never be urged before this Commission or any other rate fixing body as a measure of value of said property for rate fixing or any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.
- 2. Applicant Riley shall immediately cancel tariff of rates and time schedules on file with the Railroad Commission covering service, certificate for which is herein authorized to be transferred. Such cancellation to be in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51.
- 3. Applicant Blue shall immediately file, in duplicate, in his own name, or adopt as his own the tariff of rates and time schedules heretofore filed by applicant Riley covering said service. All tariff of rates and time schedules to be identical with those as filed by applicant Riley.
- 4. The rights and privileges herein anthorized to be transferred may not be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such discontinuance, sale, lease, transfer or assignment has first been secured.
