FIFTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY in a supplemental petition filed in the above entitled matter on October 29, 1923, reports that during the month of September it expended for extensions, additions and betterments to its plants and properties the sum of \$394,831.26 of which \$320,105.14, according to the company, is properly chargeable to capital account and has not heretofore been paid or provided for through the issue of stock or bonds. In addition, it reports that during the month of October it expended \$39,000. in constructing its ten million cubic foot gas holder which amount, added to \$320,105.14, results in the total of \$359,105.14.

The company asks the Commission to make an order authorizing it to use the proceeds from the sale of \$269,328.86 of the bonds authorized by Decision Number 12215, dated June 15th, 1923, to finance in part the cost of these extensions, additions and betterments which are described in some detail in a statement filed with the supplemental petition.

The Commission has given consideration to applicant's request and believes it should be granted as herein provided.

WHEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY be, and it is hereby authorized to use, on or after the

date hereof, the proceeds from the sale of \$269,328.86 of the bonds authorized by Decision Number 12215, dated June 15th, 1923, to finance in part such portion of the cost of the extensions, additions and betterments referred to herein as is properly chargeable to capital account as defined by the uniform system of account prescribed by this Commission.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the order in Decision Number 12215, dated June 15th, 1923, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect except as modified by this Fifth Supplemental Order.
