ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, having
on November 15, 1923, filed with the Commission an application for
permission to construct an extension of one hundred and fifteen
(115) feet to present spur track serving the Torrance Window Glass
Company in Border Avenue at grade in the City of Torrance, County
of Los Angeles, State of California as hereinafter indicated, and
it appearing to the Commission that this is not a case in which a
public hearing is necessary; that the necessary permit (Resolution
No. 145) has been granted by Board of Trustees of said City of
Torrance for the construction of said extension at grade, and that
this application should be granted subject to the conditions here-
inafter specified,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that permission be and it is here-
by granted Pacific Electric Railway Company to construct an
extension of one hundred and fifteen (115) feet to present spur

track serving the Torrance Window Glass Company at grade along Border Avenue between 218th and 222nd Streets in the City of Torrance, County of Los Angeles, State of California.

All of the above as shown by the map (C.E.H. 7263) attached to the application; said extension to be constructed subject to the following conditions, viz:-

(1) The entire expense of constructing the extension, together with the cost of its maintenance thereafter in good and first-class condition for the safe and convenient use of the public, shall be borne by applicant.

(2) Applicant shall, within thirty (30) days thereafter, notify this Commission, in writing, of the completion of the installation of said extension.

(3) The Commission reserves the right to make such further orders relative to the location, construction, operation, maintenance and protection of said extension as to it may seem right and proper, and to revoke its permission if, in its judgment, the public convenience and necessity demand such action.

This order shall become effective three (3) days after the making thereof.
