ORDER

John L. Joslin and Bert Myers have filed an application with the Railroad Commission in which they petition for an order authorizing Joslin to sell and Myers to purchase and operate a certain automotive stage line at the present time being operated between Paso Robles and Annette and intermediate points, California.

The operative right herein proposed to be transferred was obtained by applicant Joslin under Decision No. 10822 in Application No. 8106, dated August 3, 1922, and authorizes operation of an automotive stage line as a common carrier of passengers, freight and express between points hereinabove mentioned.

The consideration to be paid for the property proposed to be transferred is given as the sum of \$3,000.00 and includes in addition to the operative right one Dodge Commercial truck and one Dodge Graham Bros. Truck.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be, and the same hereby is granted, subject to the following conditions:

1. The consideration to be paid for the property herein authorized to be transferred shall never be urged before this Commission or any other rate fixing body as a measure of value of said property for rate fixing or any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.

2. Applicant Joslin shall immediately cancel all tariff of rates and time schedules now on file with the Commission covering service, certificate for which is herein authorized to be transferred. Such cancellation to be in accordance with the provisions of General Order 51.

3. Applicant Myers shall immediately file, in duplicate, in his own name, tariff of rates and time schedules, or adopt as his own the tariff of rates and time schedules now on file with the Commission by applicant Joslin covering said service. All tariff of rates and time schedules to be identical with those as filed by applicant Joslin.

4. The rights and privileges herein authorized to be transferred shall not be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such discontinuance, sale, lease, transfer or assignment has first been secured.

5. No vehicle may be operated by applicant Myers unless such vehicle is owned by said applicant or is leased by him under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
