ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation,  
has applied for authority to abandon and remove a waiting station  
at Ocean Park, California, located at Second and Hill Streets  
on the Lagoon Line of applicant's railway, alleging that the  
station proposed to be abandoned is old and dilapidated and  
no longer useful; that it is proposed to replace the station  
with one of a standard type designated as Type E-11.

An inspection having been made and the new substitute  
waiting station having been constructed and now available for the  
use of the public, we are of the opinion that this is not a  
matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the ap-  
plication should be granted.
