BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of the Application of CALIFORNIA TRANSIT COMPANY, a public corporation, to lease its operative rights between Stockton in San Joaquin County, and Byrom in Contra Costa County.

ORDER

California Transit Company, a corporation, has filed a joint application with E. M. Huston in which they apply for an order authorizing the corporation to lease to Huston a certain automotive passenger stage line operated between Stockton, San Joaquin County, California and Byron, Contra Costa County, California, and intermediate points.

The lease agreement, a copy of which is attached to the application provides that the operative right shall be leased one or more years to be terminated upon written notice from either party, the consideration being \$25.00, payable each and every month.

This lease is similar to one heretofore authorized to be executed between the same parties covering the same identical operative right.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY OFFERED that the above entitled application be, and the same hereby is granted.
