## ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of certain spur tracks formerly serving property of the Los Angeles Investment Company and located near 20th Street and Long Beach Avenue in the City of Los Angeles as shown on a blue print map marked C.E.H. 7385 and filed as Exhibit "A" attached to the application.

Applicant alleges that the spur tracks were originally installed to serve a lumber yard and that the property served by such tracks has been sold to another

industry which has no use for the spur track facilities and desires same immediately removed that a building may be constructed upon the location now occupied by said tracks.

We are of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted.
