FOURTEENTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

MIDLAND COUNTIES PUBLIC SERVICE CORPORATION, having reported to the Railroad Commission that it has on hand the proceeds received from the sale of \$26,054.12 of the bonds authorized by Decision Number 11038, dated September 29, 1922, and having asked permission to use such proceeds to finance in part the cost of extensions, additions and betterments referred to in the statement of expenditures for the month of November 1923 on file with the Railroad Commission, which cost is reported at \$41,242.52, and the Railroad Commission having considered applicant's request and being of the opinion it should be granted as herein provided,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that MIDLAND COUNTIES PUBLIC SERVICE CORPORATION be, and it is hereby, authorized to use the proceeds from the sale of \$26,054.12 of the bonds authorized by Decision Number 11038, dated September 29, 1922, to finance such of the construction expenditures referred to herein as are properly chargeable to capital account as defined by the Classification of Accounts prescribed by the Railroad Commission.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the order in Decision Number 11038, dated September 29, 1922, as amended, shall remain in

full force and effect except as modified by this Fourteenth Supplemental Order.
