Under Decision No. 8428 in the above entitled pro-

passengers between Los Angeles and Universal City. Due to
recent annexations the entire route covered by this certifi-
cate is now located solely within the corporate limits of
the City of Los Angeles.

and such service is at the present time being carried on by
one Knight.
