FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Southern Pacific Company by Decision No. 11461, dated January 3, 1923, in Application No. 8514, was authorized to construct its spur tracks at grade across First, Brannan, Bryant, Fremont, Beale, Folsom and Howard Streets in the City and County of San Francisco, State of California, in the locations as described in Ordinance No. 5748 New Series granted by said City of San Francisco, and as shown by the map attached to the application,

However, applicant on December 26, 1923, filed a request asking authority to change the location of the tracks on Beale Street between Folsom and Mission Streets so that the center lines will be parallel to and seven feet nearer the center of the street than the locations authorized in the Commission's decision referred to above.

It appears that the necessary amended franchise (Ordinance

No. 6067 New Series) has been granted by the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco, for the construction of this proposed change of location on Beale Street, and the Commission has given consideration to applicant's request and believes that it should be granted as requested.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the Commission's order in its Decision No. 11461, dated January 3, 1923, in Application No. 8514 be modified so that the tracks therein authorized shall be constructed in the locations described in said amended franchise (Ordinance No. 6067 New Series) of the City and County of San Francisco) instead of in the locations authorized in said Decision No. 11461.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, that the order in Decision No. 11461, dated January 3, 1923, shall remain in full force and effect except as modified by this first Supplemental Order.
