SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, in Decision No. 12580 in the above entitled matter, this Commission provided with reference to the steam rates of Pacific Gas and Electric Company that such rates be subject to increase or decrease upon approval of the Railroad Commission on the basis of three cents per thousand pounds of steam for each ten cent per barrel increase or decrease respectively in the cost of oil above or below the price in effect on August 1, 1923, and WHENEAS, Pacific Gas and Electric Company makes

affidavit that on January 22, 1924 the price paid for oil was increased by twenty five cents per barrel above the price in effect on August 1, 1923, and

WHEREAS, Pacific Gas and Electric Company makes further affidavit that on February 5, 1924, the price of oil again increased by 15 cents per barrel, a total of forty cents per barrel above the price in effect on August 1, 1923,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Pacific Gas and Electric Company be and it is hereby authorized to increase its rates for steam as determined in Decision No. 12580 by seven cents per one thousand pounds, effective for all regular meter readings taken on and after February 22, 1924.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, that Pacific Gas and Electric Company be and is hereby authorized to increase its rates for steam as determined in Decision No. 12580 by twelve cents per one thousand pounds, effective for all regular meter readings taken on and after March 5, 1924.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED, that the Pacific Gas and Electric Company, in case it elects to exercise this privilege, file with the Commission on or before February 22, 1924 revisions of its schedule as herein suthorized.
