ORDER

Marcus J. Pete and Raymond Cree have filed a joint application with the Railroad Commission in which they petition for an order authorizing Pete to sell and Cree to purchase and operate a certain automotive stage line.

A certificate authorizing operation of such service was obtained by applicant Pete under Decision No. 11311 in Application No. 8399, dated December 5, 1922, and authorizes operation of stage service as a common carrier of passengers, freight and express between Palm Springs and Whitewater Railroad Station.

The consideration involved is set forth in the Agreement of sale as the nominal sum of \$10.00.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be, and the same hereby is granted, subject to the following conditions:

1.

1. Applicant Pete shall immediately cancel tariff of rates and time schedules on file covering service, certificate for which is herein authorized to be transferred. Such cancellation to be in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51.

2. Applicant Cree shall immediately file, in his own name, in duplicate, tariff of rates and time schedules covering said service or shall adopt as his own the tariff of rates and time schedules as heretofore filed by applicant Pete. All tariff of rates and time schedules to be identical with those as filed by applicant Pete.

3. The rights and privileges herein authorized to be transferred may not be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such discontinuance, sale, lease, transfer or assignment has first been secured.

4. No vehicle may be operated by applicant Cree unless such vehicle is owned by said applicant or is leased by him under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
