EIGHTIETH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WESTERN STATES GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY

This Commission, on December 5, 1922, having ordered (Decision No. 11323) Western States Gas & Electric Company to reconstruct certain of its overhead electric facilities to conform with the provisions of Chapter 499, Statutes of 1911 as amended by Chapter 600, Statutes of 1915, before November 1, 1923, in its Stockton Division and before December 31, 1923, for its entire system, and Western States Gas & Electric Company having requested a further extension of time to reconstruct its facilities on San Pablo Avenue between Fairmont Avenue and Blake Street in its Richmond Division, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time during which Western States Gas & Electric Company may reconstruct its facilities on San Pablo Avenue between Fairmont and Blake Street in its Richmond Division to conform with the provisions of Chapter 499, Statutes of 1911 as amended by Chapter 600, Statutes of 1915, be and the same is hereby extended to June 1, 1924.
