O R D E R

East Bay Water Company, a corporation, having made application to this Commission for authority to sell certain real property and to grant unto Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, rights of way and easements over and across the lands of said East Bay Water Company for the purpose of erecting lines for the transmission of electric energy; and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that East Bay Water Company, a corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to sell that certain real property and to grant unto Pacific Gas and Electric Company those certain rights of way and easements which are particularly described in the application herein, upon the following conditions:

1. The consideration given for the transfer of this property shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of value of the property for rate fixing or for any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.

2. The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall have been completed on or before August 31, 1924, and certified copies of the instruments of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by said East Bay Water Company within thirty (30) days from the date on which they are executed.
3. Within ten (10) days from the date on which East Bay Water Company actually relinquishes control and possession of the property herein authorized to be conveyed, it shall file with this Commission a certified statement indicating the date upon which such control and possession was relinquished.
