M. H. Dailey having made application to this Commission for an order to sell and transfer all of his right, title, and interest in a telephone line running from the town of Azusa, California, into San Gabriel Canyon, a distance of approximately fifteen (15) miles, for the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00); and Ralph M. Follows having made application to purchase all of the right, title, and interest of M. H. Dailey in said telephone line; and it appearing to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is required, and there appearing no good reason why this application should not be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that M. H. Dailey be, and he is, hereby authorized to sell and transfer to Ralph M. Follows all of his right, title, and interest in the telephone line above described for the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00), and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Ralph M. Follows be, and he is, hereby authorized to purchase and acquire said line; providing, that the transfer shall be made within a period of

sixty (60) days from the date of this order, and further providing that a certified copy of the deed of sale of said property be filed with this Commission within a period of fifteen (15) days after the execution thereof.
