J. S. Cain having applied to the Railroad Commission for authority to discontinue public utility electric service in the town of Bodie, Mono County, said application showing that J. S. Cain delivers such electric utility service to but one consumer in the town of Bodie, and that the expense of maintaining such service is far in excess of the revenue received, and the Railroad Commission being of the opinion that such service cannot reasonably be continued by J. S. Cain under the conditions now existing in Bodie,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that J. S. Cain be and he is authorized to discontinue the public utility service of electricity for lighting and other purposes in the town of Bodie, Mono County.
