FOURTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Railroad Commission by Decision Number 12656, dated September 24, 1923, as amended, authorized Centerville Water Company to issue and sell \$25,000.00 of its first mortgage bonds and to use approximately \$18,500.00 of the proceeds to pay indebtedness and to finance the cost of metering the company's system.

On March 22, 1924 by Decision Number 13303, which was the third supplemental order in the above entitled matter, the Commission authorized the company to use an additional \$2,102.02 of the proceeds from the sale of its bonds to finance the cost of additions and betterments described as follows :-

The company requests permission to use an additional \$600.00 of the proceeds obtained from the sale of its bonds to pay the cost of labor necessary to install these additions and betterments, which request the Commission has considered and believes should be granted as provided herein, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that CENTERVILLE WATER COMPANY be, and it is hereby, authorized to use an additional \$600.00 of the proceeds obtained from the sale of the bonds authorized by Decision Number 12656, dated September 24, 1923, as amended, to finance the cost of labor necessary to install the additions and betterments, to which reference is made herein.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the Order in Decision Number 12656, dated September 24, 1923, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect except as modified by this Fourth Supplemental Order.
