The Commission having been advised that public convenience and necessity no longer requires the operation of an auto stage line for the transportation of passengers, freight and express between Quincy and Portola and intermediate points, and between Quincy and Crescent Mills and intermediate points and that service between said points has been discontinued because of the financial loss involved, and,

THEREFORE, Good cause appearing.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificates of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted by the Commission's Decision in Applications No. 6918, 6944 and 7655 and consolidated in the Commission's Decision in Application No. 7802 be, and the same hereby are revoked and annulled.
