ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a freight unloading platform at Wilmington Road in Los Angeles County, on its Wilmington—San Pedro line. Applicant alleges that there have been no shipments of freight unloaded at this point over the platform for a long period of time; that the platform is old, dilapidated and in need of repair; that the unloading platform is no longer necessary in the operation of the freight service of the applicant; and that there are no deed restrictions or other contractual arrangements requiring the continued maintenance of the platform.

An inspection having been made, the Commission being now fully advised and of the opinion that this is a matter in

which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HERHBY ORDERED that this application be, and the same hereby is granted.
