SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

This Commission by Decision No. 13164, dated February 16, 1924, having made its order preliminary to the issuance of a certificate of public convenience and necessity, and having declared therein that it would thereafter issue, upon supplemental application by Bear Valley Utility Company and a showing that a proper operative franchise had been acquired, a certificate of public convenience and necessity; and Bear Valley Utility Company having made such supplemental application and having furnished the Commission a copy of Ordinance No. 224, dated February 4, 1924, of the Board of Supervisors of San Bernardino County granting to it a franchise to construct, operate and maintain a water distribution system; and it appearing that the certificate should now be granted,

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require and will

require the operation by Bear Valley Utility Company, a corporation, of a public utility water system in that portion of San Bernardino County described in the ordinance referred to herein.
