ORDER

Raymond Cree and Charles W. Crandall have filed an application with the Railroad Commission in which they petition for an order authorizing applicant Cree to sell and applicant Crandall to purchase and operate a certain automotive stage line.

The operative right proposed to be transferred was obtained by Cree by purchase from Marcus J. Pete, with the approval of the Railroad Commission, as shown in its Decision and Order in Application No. 9775. The certificate authorizes the operation of an automotive stage line for the transportation of passengers, freight and express between Palm Springs and Whitewater Station.

The consideration to be paid is set forth in the agreement of sale as the sum of \$1,350.00 of which amount \$767 represents the value of the equipment and \$585 the value of the operative right.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be, and the same hereby is granted, subject to the following conditions:

1. The consideration to be paid for the property herein authorized to be transferred shall never be urged before this Commission or any other rate fixing body as a measure of value of said property for rate fixing or any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.

2. Applicant Cree shall immediately cancel all tariff of rates and time schedules now on file covering service herein authorized to be transferred. Such cancellation to be in accordance with the provisions of General Order No. 51.

3. Applicant Crandall shall immediately file, in duplicate, tariff of rates and time schedules, or adopt as his own the tariff of rates and time schedules as filed by applicant Cree covering service, certificate for which is herein authorized transferred. All tariff of rates and time schedules must be identical with those as heretofore filed by applicant Cree.

4. The rights and privileges herein authorized transferred shall not be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such discontinuance, sale, lease, transfer or assignment has first been secured.

5. No vehicle may be operated by applicant Crandall unless such vehicle is owned by said applicant or is leased under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
