FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The order in Decision Number 13267, dated March 14, 1924,
 in the above entitled applications, reads in part as follows :-

"The Railroad Commission hereby declares that hereafter,
 upon the filing herein of a certified copy of an ordinance
 of the County of San Bernardino granting to the Arrowhead

Utility Company a franchise, and the filing of a duly and legally executed stipulation, as set forth in the opinion that precedes this order, the Railroad Commission will declare that public convenience and necessity require and will require the exercise by Arrowhead Utility Company of the rights and privileges granted to it by such Ordinance, subject to such terms and conditions as the Railroad Commission may prescribe."

On April 17th. Arrowhead Utility Company filed with the Commission a certified copy of a franchise (Ordinance No. 228) granted by the Board of Supervisors of San Bernardino County, together with a stipulation duly executed, in which it agrees never to claim a value for such franchise in excess of the cost thereof which cost is reported at \$280.86. Both the franchise and the stipulation are in satisfactory form. Therefore the Railroad Commission hereby declares that public convenience and necessity require the exercise by Arrowhead Utility Company of the rights and privileges conferred by Ordinance No. 228 of the County of San Bernardino, adopted by the Board of Supervisors of said County on March 24, 1924.
