FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Order in the above entitled proceedings as

Applicant. Motor Transit Company, by its attorney has made written request for an extension of time in which to prepare and file with this Commission, the acceptance, tariffs and time schedules, and rules and regulations governing same.

We are of the opinion that the request is a reasonable one and that it should be granted, and

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant, Motor Transit Company, be and it hereby is required to file not later than June 15, 1924 the acceptances, revised tariffs and time schedules and rules and regulations governing same as heretofore ordered by the provisions of Decision Number 13454 herein.
