ORDER

Pacific Gas and Electric Company, Lessee of the electric system of Sierra and San Francisco Power Company, having applied to the Railroad Commission for an Order approving an agreement entered into between said Company and Calaveras Copper Company, dated July 3, 1923, which agreement provides that, in consideration of the extension and improvement of Pacific Gas and Electric Company's electrical distribution system, said Calaveras Copper Company will purchase electric energy from Pacific Gas and Electric Company for a term of five years and to a gross amount of at least \$31,320.00 during such term, and the Railroad Commission being of the opinion that the terms of said agreement are reasonable, and other good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the agreement entered into on July 3, 1923, by and between Pacific Gas and Electric Company, Lessee, and Calaveras Copper Company be, and the same is approved.
