SUPPLELENTAL OFDER

The Railroad Commission having on April 15, 1924, made its Decision No. 13409 authorizing, among other things, the exercise by Southern California Edison Company of certain franchise rights and privileges in a portion of Kings County, and as the recult of a typographical error the word "west" having been used in said Decision where the word "east" was intended,

IT IS HERRBY ONDERED that the last paragraph of the Order in said Decision No. 13409 be and it is amended to read as follows:

THE FATHROLD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES THAT public convonience and necessity require the exercise by San Josephin Light and Power Corporation of the franchise rights and privileges granted by Ordinance No. 25 of

Mings County, limited, however, to the area lying outside and generally west of the boundary line described in applicant's Revised Exhibit No. 4 in this matter, and the exercise by Southern California Idison Company of the franchise rights and privileges granted by Ordinance No. 104 of Mings County, limited, however, to the area lying within and generally east of the boundary line described in applicants' Revised Exhibit No. 4 in this matter."
