ORDER

PACIFIC ELECTRIC PAILWAY COMPANY, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a freight platform located at Mountain Street, Glendale, on its Glendale Line, the location being more particularly shown on a blue print map marked "C.E.H.7833" as attached to the application herein.

applicant alleges that the freight platform herein proposed to be abandoned is no longer useful for the business of applicant; that the territory adjacent to the platform has developed into a residential district and that there is now no demand for freight service; that no freight has been shipped from or received at this point for a period of over two years; that the platform is located at the end of the line and in a position where it obstructs the view of the public using Brand Boulevard and Mountain Street; that the Chamber of Commerce of the City of Glendale has

requested the removal of the platform in order that the view of the users of the above highways may be unobstructed; and that there are no deed restrictions, conditions or agreements requiring the continued maintenance of a freight platform at this location.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and the same hereby is granted.
