This is an application by ADDISON H. ELLIOT for a certificate of public convenience and necessity under which to operate an automotive service for the transportation of passengers, freight, express and baggage between Hollister and Cienega and intermediate points. The applicant transports mail under contract with the United States Government between the points named and wishes to be in a position legally to transport such merchandise and passengers as offer. His schedule calls for three round trips a week at rates that are fully set forth in Exhibit "A", accompanying his application.

There are no other means of transportation between Hollister and Cienega.

We believe that this application should be granted, and that there is no necessity for a public hearing.

HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require the operation by Addison H. Elliot of an automotive service for the transportation of passengers, freight, express and baggage between Hollister and Cienega and intermediate points; and

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a certificate of public convenience and necessity be, and the same hereby is granted to said applicant, subject to the following conditions:-

1.-Applicant shall file his written accepttance of the certificate herein granted within a period of not to exceed ten (10) days from date hereof; shall file, in duplicate, tariff of rates and time schedules within a poriod of not to exceed twenty (20) days from date hereof, such tariff of rates and time schedules to be identical with those attached to the application herein; and shall commence operation of said service within a period of not to exceed sixty (60) days from date hereof.

2.-The rights and privileges herein authorized may not be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such discontinuance, sale, lease, transfer or assignment has first been secured.

3.-No vehicle may be operated by applicant herein unless such vehicle is owned by said applicant or is leased by him under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
