FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Railroad Commission by Decision Number 13603, dated May 26, 1924, authorized San Joaquin Light and Power Corporation to issue and sell \$1,500,000.00 of its unifying and refunding six per cent Series "C" of 1954 bonds, subject, among others, to the condition that such authority will not become effective until there has been filed with the Commission, in satisfactory form, a copy of the company's Series "C" of 1954 bond.

On June 2, 1924 the Company filed with the Commission a copy of its proposed form of bond. It appears to the Commission that the proposed bond is in satisfactory form, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that SAN JOAQUIN LIGHT AND POWER CORPORATION be, and it is hereby, authorized to execute a bond or bonds substantially in the same form as that filed with the Commission on June 2, 1924 in the above entitled matter.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the Order in Decision Number 13603, dated May 26, 1924 shall remain in full force and effect except as modified by this First Supplemental Order.
