BY THE COMMISSION:

O P I N I O N

In this proceeding the San Gabriel Valley Water Company, a corporation, asks authority to transfer certain distribution pipe lines and the services attached thereto, to the City of Pasadena, which joins in the application.

A public hearing in this matter was held at Los Angeles before Examiner Satterwhite, after all interested parties had been duly notified and given an opportunity to appear and be heard.

The testimony shows that the San Gabriel Valley Water Company owns certain distribution pipe lines and service pipes attached thereto located in that portion of the City of Pasadena known as Lamanda Park, which was annexed to the City in 1921. The City of Pasadena now desires to acquire these water distribution facilities and to operate the same as a part of its municipal water system. The testimony shows that all consumers now supplied

through these facilities will be served by the City of Pasadena. It was further shown that all pumping plants, tanks, transmission pipes and distribution mains owned by the San Gabriel Valley Water Company which are required to supply consumers located outside the limits of the City of Pasadena, will be retained by that company.

No one appeared to protest the granting of this application, and it is evident that the interests of consumers will not be affected adversely if the transfer be authorized.

O R D E R

Application having been made to this Commission as entitled above, a public hearing having been held thereon, the matter having been submitted and the Commission being now fully informed in the matter,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that San Gabriel Valley Water Company, a corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to transfer to the City of Pasadena that portion of its distribution pipe system, together with the service pipes, meters, valves and fittings attached thereto, located in that part of the City of Pasadena known as Lamanda Park, upon the following conditions:

1. The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall have been completed on or before August 31, 1924, and a certified copy of the instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by said San Gabriel Valley Water Company, a corporation, within thirty (30) days from the date on which it is executed.
2. Within ten (10) days from the date on which San Gabriel Valley Water Company, a corporation, actually relinquishes control and possession of the property herein authorized to be sold, it shall file with this Commission a certified statement indicating the date upon which such control and possession was relinquished.

3. The consideration given for the transfer of this property shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of value of the property for rate fixing or for any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.
