ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment of Center Street Station in the City of Los Angeles (San Pedro district) the removal of the station and the elimination of the station name from the records of the applicant.

The application alleges that the station herein proposed to be abandoned was formerly used as a passenger station but is not now so used and has not been used for a period of approximately seventeen years and that no business of any kind is now transacted at said station; that applicant now maintains two other stations in the San Pedro district of the City of Los Angeles, one known as Pt. Firmin Station and the other the main station of the applicant at Fifth and Front Streets, San Pedro; that such two stations now adequately serve patrons transacting business with the applicant in San Pedro; that the Center Street Station is not now required by the public or the applicant in connection with its business; and that there is no future prospective use for said station.

An investigation having been made by a representative of the Commission; the Commission being now fully advised and of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant, Southern Pacific Company, be and the same hereby is authorized to abandon Center Street Station in the San Pedro District of the City of Los Angeles, County of Los Angeles, State of California, to remove the station building, and to eliminate Center Street, San Pedro, as a station of record.
