ORDER

Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company, a corporation,
has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing
the discontinuance of its agency station at Whittier Junction,
Los Angeles County, California.

Applicant alleges that the station was originally es-
tablished in November 1923 to serve the business of the O'Donnell-
Gillette Refining Company; that such company has been the only
receiver or shipper of freight at such station; that no pas-
senger business has ever been handled at the station; that the
business now transacted at Whittier Junction Station can be
satisfactorily handled at the agency station of Pico, located
.53 miles west of Whittier Junction; and that the only shipper
and receiver of freight at Whittier Junction desires to hereafter
transact its business at Pico Station as evidenced by a copy of
a letter made a portion of the application herein.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a
public hearing is not necessary and that the application should
be granted.
