ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the discontinuance of its agency station at Pinedale Junction in the County of Fresno on its San Joaquin Division, the station to be thereafter maintained as a non-agency station.

Applicant alleges that the maintenance of the agency station is unremunerative; that practically all of the freight business handled at the station is that interchanged with the Minarets & Western Railway Company; that no passenger business is handled or tickets sold at said station; and that the future maintenance of Finedale Junction as a non-agency station will not affect the proper handling of interchange business with the Minarets & Western Railway Company and will furnish adequate service and facilities to the public until sufficient additional traffic develops and justifies the re-establishment

of an agency station.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant, Southern Pacific Company, be and it is hereby authorized to discontinue the agency station now maintained at Pinedale Junction in Fresno County on its San Josquin Division and to hereafter until otherwise ordered by this Commission maintain such station as a non-agency station.
