O R D E R

This proceeding is an application by E.B.Brown
for a certificate of convenience and necessity to operate an
automotive passenger and express transportation service bet-
ween Needles, California, and a point on the California-Nevada
Stage Line to Searchlight, Nevada.

There are no means of transportation between Needles
and the point on the California-Nevada State Line proposed to
be served by the applicant.

We are of the opinion that this is not a matter in
which a public hearing is required and that the application
should be granted.

THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA
HEREBY DECLARES that public convenience and necessity require
the operation of an automotive service for the transportation
of passengers and express between Needles and a point on the
California-Nevada State Line and intermediate points on the
road to Searchlight, Nevada, and

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a certificate of public convenience and necessity be, and the same is hereby granted, subject to the following provisions:

1. Applicant Brown shall immediately file, his written acceptance of the certificate herein granted within a period of not to exceed ten (10) days from date hereof; shall file within a period of not to exceed twenty (20) days from date hereof, in duplicate, tariff of rates and time schedules, identical with those filed as exhibits with the application herein; and shall commence service herein authorized within a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days from date hereof.

2. The rights and privileges herein authorized may not be discontinued, sold, leased, transferred nor assigned unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such discontinuance, sale, lease, transfer or assignment has first been secured.

3. No vehicle may be operated by applicant Brown unless such vehicle is owned by said applicant or is leased under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
