O P I N I O N

Crystal Springs Water Company, a corporation, makes application for authority to dispose of real estate, pumping equipment and other facilities comprising the water system which supplied consumers in that portion of the City of Los Angeles formerly known as Sawtelle.

A public hearing in this proceeding was held before Examiner Satterwhite at Los Angeles, after due notice thereof had been given so that all interested parties might appear and be heard. At the same time and place a hearing was had in Application No. 10012 of Crystal Springs Water Company, in which the Commission was asked to authorize discontinuance of water service. In this latter proceeding the Commission on June 13, 1924, rendered Decision No. 13696, which authorized the discontinuance of service on July 1st, 1924, under certain conditions, which the record shows have been fully complied with. A decision in Application No. 10031 was reserved pending final discontinuance of service by applicant.

No one appeared to protest the granting of either application, and it is evident that the real estate, pumping equipment and other facilities comprising this water system are no longer required in the service of the public; that applicant should be relieved of public utility obligations; and that authority to dispose of the property should be granted.

O R D E R

Crystal Springs Water Company, a corporation, having made application as entitled above, a public hearing having been held thereon, the matter having been submitted and the Commission being now fully informed in the matter,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Crystal Springs Water Company, a corporation, be and the same is hereby relieved of any public utility obligation with which it may be impressed, and be and the same is hereby permitted to dispose of the real estate, pumping equipment and other facilities heretofore used in supplying water to its consumers in that portion of the City of Los Angeles formerly known as Sawtelle.
