BY THE COMMISSION,

ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the removal of its station of Nutglade in Shasta County on its Shasta Division to a new location at a point approximately eight-tenths of a mile east of its present location.

Applicant alleges that the non-agency station of Nutglade is maintained principally for the accommodation of its employees and for the receipt and delivery of applicant's material in the yards and shops at such point; and that there is no passenger traffic handled from said station.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant, Southern Pacific Company, be and it hereby is authorized to change its non-

agency station of Nutglade in Shasta County on its Shasta Division from its present location to a point approximately eight-tenths of a mile easterly, by time-table direction, and to hereafter maintain such non-agency station at the new location until the further order of this Commission.
