BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

T. P. Gorham having made application for authority to transfer a certain public utility water system located in the town of San Miguel, San Luis Obispo County, to San Luis Obispo County Water Works District No. 1, which joins in the application, and it appearing that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that T. P. Gorham be and he is hereby authorized to transfer to San Luis Obispo County Water Works District No. 1 a certain public utility water system located in the town of San Miguel, San Luis Obispo County, and more particularly described in the application herein, upon the following conditions:

1. The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as is actually completed on or before September 30, 1924, and a certified copy of the instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by San Luis Obispo County Water Works District No. 1 on or before October 31, 1924.
2. Within ten (10) days of the date on which possession and control of the property herein authorized to be transferred is actually relinquished to San Luis Obispo

County Water Works District No. 1, a certified statement to that effect shall be filed with this Commission by T. P. Gorham; or, in case the said Water Works District No. 1 is already in control and possession of the property, a certified statement to that effect shall be filed within thirty (30) days of the date hereof.

3. The consideration given for the transfer of this property shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of value for rate fixing or for any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.
