Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the closing of its agency station at Glamis in Imperial County on its Los Angeles Division until such time as traffic conditions will justify the re-establishment of an agency.

Applicant elleges that the maintenance of an agency is at the present unremunerative; that the salary of agent averages \$170.00 per month which amount is not justified by the volume of business transacted; and that the maintenance of Glamis as a non-agency station will furnish adequate service to the public until such time as additional traffic will have been developed justifying the restoration of an agent.

We have carefully considered the statements of revenue and tonnage filed as exhibits herein, and are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant, Southern Pacific Company, be and the same hereby is authorized to discontinue the maintenance of an agency station at Glamis on its Los Angeles Division in Imperial County and to hereafter maintain and operate said station as a non-agency station until the further order of this Commission.
