ORDER DENYING MODIFICATION

On February 19, 1924, the Commission issued its Decision No. 13177 under which it granted to one A.B. Watson the right to operate through stage service between Los Angeles and Santa Ana and to transport in connection therewith express packages not to exceed thirty pounds in weight per package.

Now comes the applicant and asks that said Decision be modified to the extent of permitting recipient of said certificate to transport packages not exceeding seventy-five pounds in weight each, and the petition failing to set forth sufficient grounds which would warrant the Commission in modifying its previous order as hereinabove numbered to the extent requested in said petition, and

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that said petition for modification of Decision No. 13177 be, and the same hereby is denied.
