O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the discontinuance of its agency station at Chualar in Monterey County, on its Coast Division.

Applicant alleges that the maintenance of an agency station at Chualar is unremunerative and is not justified by the amount of business transacted at such station at the present time; and that the future maintenance and operation of said station as a non-agency will furnish adequate service to the public until such time as the development of additional traffic will justify the re-establishment of an agency station.

We have carefully considered the tonnage and revenue statements filed as exhibits in support of the application and are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant, Southern Pacific

Company, be and it heroby is authorized to discontinue the operation of its agency station at Chular in Monterey County on its Coast Division and to hereafter maintain said station of Chular as a non-agency station until the further order of this Commission.
