BY THE COMMISSION:

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, applicant herein, made written request on June 24, 1924 that the restrictions imposed on switching movements over crossing granted in this matter, as set forth in Condition 3 of this Commission's Decision No. 13714, be eliminated for the reason that the restrictions were very burdensome to the railroad company, for the reason that the industry is located outside of the switching limits and must be served by road engines at any time during the day.

Southern Pacific Company, through the industry served, has supplied the Commission with certain data, from which it appears that Sections 3 and 4 of said order should be revoked and replaced by modified conditions.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Sections (3) and (4) of this Commission's Decision No. 13714 dated June 16, 1924 be and they are hereby revoked and new Sections (3) and (4) be and they are hereby inserted in said order to read as follows:

(3) Said crossing shall not be operated over by locomotive, train or car more than four times (two moves in each direction) per day and shall not be operated

over at all on Sundays and legal holidays.

(4) No locomotive, car or train shall be operated over said crossing unless traffic on the highway be protected by members of the train crew or other competent employees carrying suitable warning equipment, who shall have stationed themselves at least three hundred (300) feet, measured along said San Fernando Road in opposite directions respectively from said crossing for the purpose of warning approaching highway traffic.

In all other respects this Commission's Decision No. 13714 dated the 16th day of June, 1924, in this matter shall remain in full force and effect.
