ORDER

This is an application by Thos. Cheney to lease to Harry Gee operative rights to conduct an auto freight and passenger transportation service between Santa Monica and Topanga Canyon (Outside Inn) and a passenger transportation service to Los Flores. The operative rights it is proposed to lease were obtained by Cheney from the Railroad Commission in Application No. 9484.

The lease, approval of which is sought, is to run for one year, and covers equipment as well as operative rights. The nominal sum of \$1.00 is given as the consideration.

We believe that this application should be granted and that it is not a matter requiring a public hearing.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be, and the same hereby is granted subject to the following conditions:

1. That applicant, Thomas Cheney, shall file a cancellation of his tariffs and time schedules and applicant Harry Gee shall file an adoption of the existing tariffs and time schedules now on file in the name of Cheney, both such cancellation and adoption to expire one year from date effective.

2. No vehicle may be operated by Harry Gee unless such vehicle is owned by him or is leased by him under a contract or agreement on a basis satisfactory to the Railroad Commission.
